How long Rumah Beribu Bintang was made?

The idea started out at 2015 and it slowly and surely developed along the years. The production of the final film started at 2021 right in middle of the chaos of the pandemics.

Why orangutans?

I was having fun looking at baby animals when I found a photo of baby orangutan that struck a chord in me. As someone who takes care of the various kids in my family, I feel an instant affection to them. And after a long time researching more into it, I found out about their misfortunes and the way their livelihood is endangered by human activities. I wanted to try share their story, so I decided to make a film about that.

Why did you choose the narration?

There are so many things I'd like to convey with this film, but I am too inexperience to do so without feeling like a little kid lecturing grownups.

I accidentally found this script my great grandfather wrote so many years ago and it feels in my heart like it speaks up to what I have in mind this whole time. He wrote it during the time after Indonesia finally reached independence and I think in his world at that time he saw many injustices and the same near-sightedness around him as well. Even though the topics are different, the sentiments are the same.

And in a personal point of view, I've never had a chance to meet him, and I feel like reading his works and have it speaks to me like that makes me feel closer to him.

INDONESIAN

Bintang2 itu semua bergerak dan berputaran menurut aturan yang tertentu.


















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
